Vinification:

Careful vinification procedure. This wine was allowed to mature for 14 months to oak barrels

Characteristics:

Purple-red color, rich red-fruit and flowery aromas, elegant nose, harmonious or palate.

Alcohol: 13,5 % vol, Acidity: 5,5 g/l, Residual sugar: 1,2 g/l

Ageing ability:

Ready to drink between the 2nd and 6th year.
